Election Schedule for Election of Karate Association of India to be held on 23.09.2018


1.	Receipt of nominations by Returning Officer	From 9 th September 2018 between 11 AM to 1 PM	To 11 th September 2018 between 11 AM to 1 PM
2.	Publication of list of all nomination received by Returning Officer	As soon as after 1.00 PM on 11 th September 2018	
3.	Scrutiny of nomination and publication of valid nominations	From 4.30 PM onwards on 14 th September 2018	
4.	Withdrawal of nomination/candidature	From 11.00 AM to 1.00 PM on 16 th September 2018	
5.	Publication of final list of contesting candidates	As soon as after 1.00 PM on 16 th September 2018	
6.	Election/Polling to be held	From 11.00 AM onwards on 23 rd September 2018	
7.	Counting of Votes	on 23 rd September 2018 after polling	
8.	Publication of Results by Returning Officer	As soon as completion of counting of votes on 23 rd September 2018	

Note: The activities mentioned items 1 to 5 above shall be held at the office of the Returning Officer of the KAI election at **G-1, Plot No. 18, DDA Community Centre, B1 Market, Janak Puri, New Delhi – 110058.**

1. The election of the office bearer would be held as per the MOA of the Karate Association of India.
2. The nomination of a candidate for election as office bearer shall be proposed by (one) of the representative of Member's State Association whose name is included in the Electoral College in Form 1 and also subscribed by (One) such representative as seconder.
3. No person shall be eligible to nominate more than one candidate for the same post, either as a proposer or seconder and, if he so does, his/her signature on the nomination paper delivered second in point of time to Returning Officer shall be deemed to be inoperative.
4. No person shall be permitted to withdraw his/her name as a proposer/seconder, once the nomination paper subscribed by him/her has been delivered to the returning officer.
